- The results of votes regarding the George South project were emailed to residents on Tue Oct 29th. HHCA trustees have begun conversations about the next steps for this project. Summaries and updates will be posted in this newsletter.
- Discussions at our November meeting included appointing James as lead trustee for this project, starting the process of vetting the dock waiting list with the intention of posting it on the HHCA website in the future, contacting approval agencies, and drawing up new purchase contracts.
