## MONTHLY TRUSTEE MEETING SUMMARY – JUNE 2025

- **PARK CLEANUP:** A contract was awarded to do the clean-up at George South Park. The scope of this work is for underbrush cleanup, grading, seeding, and landscaping.

- **HHCA 4<sup>th</sup> of July Celebration:** At our June meeting, trustees voted to cancel the parade portion of this event. The neighborhood road conditions make golf carting and biking challenging on a solo basis. These safety concerns and excessive dust were our main considerations in this difficult decision. The celebration will continue to include live music by Mike Hawley and a bouncy house for the kids. Trustees will be grilling up those yummy “big hotdogs” for your enjoyments as well and handing out chips and water. Kona Ice will be on site with treats as too. Please join us and your fellow neighbors! This event will be Friday July 4 from 11AM – 1PM at East Park.
