🌸 Spring Clean-Up Reminder

Our spring roll-off dumpsters will be available in both parks from **April 13th through April 26th**. To help keep costs down for everyone, please make sure only approved items are placed in the dumpsters. We've been charged additional fees when prohibited materials are left behind and need to be sorted. If you're disposing of leaves, please empty them directly into the dumpster and discard the plastic bags separately. If you happen to see contractors or non-residents using the dumpsters, please gather any helpful details (company name, truck description, etc.) along with a picture or video and share them with a Trustee so we can follow up.

Trash & Bulk Pickup Guidelines

To help ensure safe and efficient pickup, please follow these guidelines:

- Items must weigh under 50 lbs and not exceed 4 ft x 4 ft in size
- Fabric items (carpet, furniture, couches/chairs, mattresses, etc.) must be wrapped in plastic
 - *Couches/sofas do not need to be cut in half*
- Additional trash: Up to 10 bags may be set out *as your one bulk item* (not both a bulk item and 10 bags)
- Push mowers are accepted (must have no gas, oil, or rubber tires)
- Toilets are accepted (tank must be separated from the base)
- Dried paint is accepted (mix with clay kitty litter and leave the lid off until fully solid)
- Yard waste (leaves, branches, twigs) must be bundled, under 4 ft in length, and less than 6" in diameter
- Aerosol cans must be punctured on the side for safety
