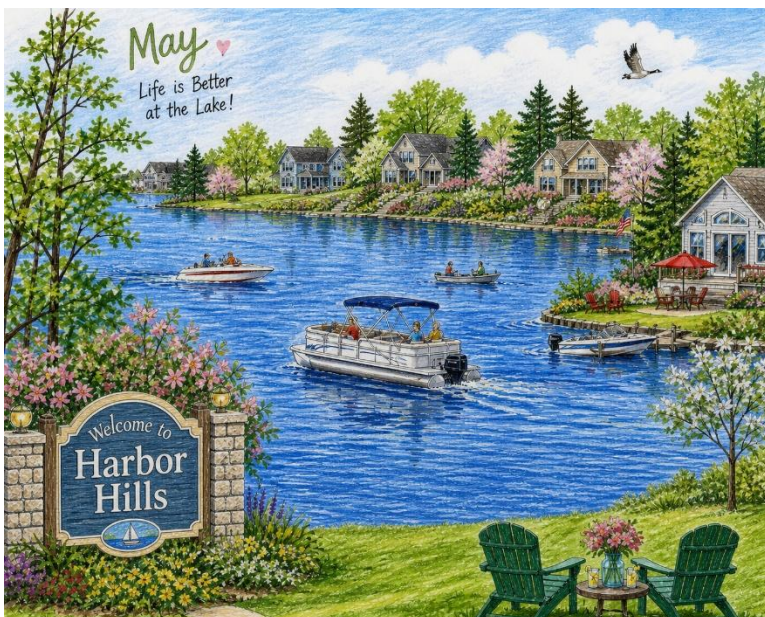
We are also currently seeking another volunteer to join the Board to take over for James Stone, as his three-year commitment concludes in September.
