No Soliciting Reminder:

Our neighborhood is a No Soliciting Community. If a solicitor comes to your door, you may politely inform them that soliciting is not permitted and end the conversation. If they persist, you may contact the Sheriff's Office non-emergency number. There is no

need to contact a trustee, as residents have the same authority to address solicitors on their property. We also recommend posting a "No Soliciting" sign or sticker on your door to help deter unwanted visitors.



Dock Ownership & Rental Reminder

If you purchase a home that includes ownership of a dock located within HH (but not on your property), please notify the HOA by emailing hhcasec@gmail.com with your contact information. Likewise, if you sell your dock to another HH resident, please email hhcasec@gmail.com so our records can be updated accordingly. Please note that dock rentals are permitted only to inland residents of HH.



Parking

We continue to see vehicles being parked in yards throughout the community. As a reminder, the restriction against yard parking was approved by a neighborhood vote. We ask all residents to respect the decision of the community and help maintain the appearance and standards of our neighborhood. Vehicles must be parked on approved driveway or designated parking surfaces only. We understand that some homeowners are in the process of adding concrete to expand their driveways. However, until the additional parking surface has been completed, vehicles may not be parked in the yard. After a homeowner has been notified of a violation, fines will be issued for continued yard parking until the violation has been corrected.

Speeding Reminder

We have received several complaints regarding speeding within the neighborhood. The safety of our residents, children, pets, and visitors depends on everyone following the posted speed limits. Please be mindful of your speed while driving through the community. If you have contractors, delivery drivers, or service providers visiting your property, please ask them to drive responsibly while in the neighborhood.

Lawn Restoration Update

We recently received notification from the county that Tuscon has completed the yard restoration work in the affected areas. Residents whose lawns were repaired may need to provide supplemental watering if we do not receive adequate rainfall. To help the new grass establish strong roots and promote healthy growth, it is recommended to water the restored areas in the evening hours, when cooler temperatures reduce evaporation.
